WARNING

**IF YOU POSSESS FIREARMS OR AMMUNITION THE FOLLOWING LANGUAGE, OR SIMILARLY WORDED LANGUAGE, THAT IS CONTAINED VIRTUALLY ALL TEMPORARY INJUNCTIONS MAY SUBJECT YOU TO FEDERAL PROSECUTION:**

1. Threatening Petitioner [Respondent/the other party] in person, by telephone, or in writing to take unlawful action against any person.
2. Intentionally, knowingly, or recklessly causing bodily injury to Petitioner [Respondent/the other party] or to a child of either party.
3. Threatening Petitioner [Respondent/the other party] or a child of either party with imminent bodily injury.

**IT IS ROUTINE PRACTICE FOR THE COURTS TO ENTER MUTUAL TEMPORARY INJUNCTIONS, WHICH INCLUDES THIS LANGUAGE. ACCORDINGLY, YOU NEED TO PLAN TO REMOVE ALL FIREARMS AND AMMUNITION FROM YOUR POSSESSION, UNLESS THE COURT MAKES A SPECIFIC EXCEPTION FOR YOUR CASE.**
